Introduction

Street Children NGOs Network (SCNN) based in Kampala District in Uganda. It is a non-profit making civil society organisation founded in 1996. It began as a simple forum of a few members to share experience in Kampala district and work towards a common goal.

In 2007 the concept and vision changed into a national advocacy program addressing various issues affecting children and leading them to street life.

SCNN is a liaison of NGOs providing support to street children subject to the laws of Uganda.

SCNN membership is currently comprised of over 20 NGOs and CBOs involved or otherwise interested in transformation of street children into useful citizens of Uganda. The organisation undertakes a range of strategic and functional activities in collaboration with government through line ministries, communities, non-government organisation and development partners.

To promote networking of NGOs, Government and communities to jointly address the problem of children living on the streets of developing urban centers in Uganda through Capacity building, Lobbying, Advocacy and Research.

- To support juvenile justice for street children in conflict with the laws as well as protecting their human rights.
- To lobby key stakeholders for provision of various resources and support necessary for the implementing and sustainability of the programs that address issues of street children.
